

**Instructions to Consort Members attending the monthly Consort meeting at
Belfast International Airport**

If approaching the Airport from the Belfast direction on the A57 Ballyrobin Road take the first entrance on your left. If approaching from Antrim go the roundabout at McCauslands and take the second entrance on your right.

Drive up to Security Checkpoint straight ahead. Stop and staff should have your name and car details. It is essential that your Name and Car Details are given to James Buchanan by Monday of the week of meeting so that this can be passed to Airport Security.

You will be given a Blue Parking Sticker to enable you to park in the staff car park. Stick this on the inside of your windscreen.

Take the right turn at the check point and drive on taking a left turn and drive on veering right past the Police Station and you will see a number of car parks. You can park in any of these which have Blue signs. **Do not park in the Red zones.**

After parking your car walk to the entrance doors to the Medway building (these are marked Bus Door) this is just opposite the Red zone car park and to the left of an old check point. These doors need to be opened for you as you are entering the Airport secure area. Ruth-Anne Morgan is our contact at the Airport and you can call her by using the wall phone near these doors. Dial 4013 and she will come and let you in. If Ruth-Anne is unavailable call Deborah Matchett on 2035. If Ruth-Anne or Deborah are not available please call James Buchanan 07866 686 857.

You then proceed through the double doors, up the stairs, turn right and down the corridor to Room 3 where our meetings are held.
